



# Literary competition

## “Future of Food”

DSM Nutrition Science & Advocacy, in collaboration with Karger Publishers and the Society of Nutrition and Food Sciences, launch for the first time a literary competition on the lookout for short stories in English on „the future of food“ , with a special focus on the interface between nutrition/food.

How does the ever so growing world population influence future diets? How will a changing lifestyle effect diets and foods? Anticipated are short stories of all genres, that are primarily reflecting on the development of nutrition for humans and animals - from a scientific and/or social perspective. The maximum length is 4000 words.

All manuscripts must yet be unpublished and all rights be with the author. Through the submission the author acknowledges the eligibility requirements and grants DSM the right to publish the rewarded text in an anthology; no costs arise for authors. Deadline for submissions is 30 November 2015.

An independent jury will consider all stories and assign the rewards, whereas the three best short stories will be granted CHF 2'000, CHF 1'000 und CHF 500 each. Out of all submissions the most appealing short stories will be published in an anthology against a honorary fee of CHF 100.
